Spring has arrived and it's time for the Estherine J. Harding Endowed Scholarship Committee to activate its plan for the 19th Annual Fundraiser.

All alumni, faculty, staff, students, family, and friends are cordially invited to participate in this effort as favor and rich blessings await this awesome endeavor. Due to the state of the economy currently, the committee has decided to conduct a mail-in campaign and forego the local breakfast.

Approximately ninety percent of NSU's student population relies on financial aid to cover the cost of their educational aspirations. Supporting scholarships demonstrates that we believe in our students, academic excellence, and creative ingenuity to help make this world a better place in which to live. Every scholarship dollar reduces a student's debt burden as well.

This committee is diligently working to increase our scholarship base. Only interest earned on the base can be used to award scholarships. The Estherine J. Harding Endowed Scholarship fund has reached a level over \$420,000. "We see the future in our students." For the 2025-26 academic year, five students will each receive \$2,000 as endowed scholars and five students will each receive \$1,000 as book scholars.
